Reorganization Meeting – January 1, 2012**

Mayor Paul A. Sarlo's Address

Good Afternoon. . Happy New Year to all of you. I hope that 2012 is healthy and prosperous for all the citizens of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

What a beautiful day we have today with temperatures reaching 60 degrees, which is a remarkable turnaround from last New Year's Day when we were still digging out from the December 26th blizzard that dumped approximately 30" of snow on our community.

Since I was first elected to the Borough Council in 1995 this is my 17th reorganization meeting that I have participated in and the 13th that I will preside over as Mayor. As I reflect back for a moment I truly cannot believe where the 12 years I have served as Mayor have gone. Our community and my personal life have endured so many changes over the past 12 years and I thank the Lord that most of them have been for the betterment.

Today's reorganization is a significant because we have sworn in Thomas Gonnella to his 6th term on the Borough Council and at 12:01 AM this morning marked his 16th year on the Council which makes him

the longest serving Councilman in the Borough of Wood-Ridge's history. Today we also sworn in Dominick Azzolini to his third term on the Council. Dom and his family are just amazing and loving people who will go to the greatest lengths to help others. Known to many throughout the town as "Coach Dom" he is adored by all ages and has made his mark as an elected official. Dom has also stepped up to the plate three years ago and assumed the difficult role as Finance Chair from Councilman Gonnella who served in that capacity for better than a decade.

Looking back on 2011, I am proud of the way our community responded to extreme weather challenges such as the devastating December 26th blizzard, snowiest winter on record., hottest July on record, Hurricane Irene, Tropical Storm Lee and the Halloween snow storm. By banding together, neighbor helping neighbor, we persevered and showed what a special town Wood-Ridge is.

I am so proud of this Borough Council, Ladies and Gentleman I truly believe that Wood-Ridge is blessed with one of the brightest, dedicated, and sincere governing bodies in the state. You will find no better Councilman then Ezio Altamura, Edward Marino, Joseph DiMarco, and Catherine Cassidy.

I am also very proud of the many achievements and tremendous progress that occurred in our Borough in 2011.

Last year we started vertical construction on the first phase of the Wesmont Station redevelopment and made the final payment of the legacy Curtiss-Wright Tax Appeal which plagued our community for decades since the Korean War.

We completed renovations and rededicated Veterans Park on Valley Boulevard; we began a total renovation of the Civic and Senior Center which will include installing an elevator, new ADA bathrooms, automatic doors, new windows and siding and numerous interior improvements; and we continued our investment in our infrastructure by installing much needed storm sewers on Union Avenue and installing new curbs, sidewalks and resurfacing numerous feeder streets into Union Avenue.

We also had another year of stellar financial results in which we maintained the third highest bond rating, our municipal budget increased by less than \$10,000, we increased our surplus, improved cash flow, retired debt and continued on a course of long-term financial stability and strength.

In 2012, I look forward to continuing this progress. Taking advantage of low interest rates and a very competitive construction industry we will complete the infrastructure improvements on Union Avenue and significant curb and sidewalk improvements and resurfacing of streets on the East side of town; we will complete the renovations to the civic and senior center and rededicate the building; we will embark on an aggressive tree planting program by planting approximately 200 trees.

In 2012 we will continue the historic progress with the Wesmont Station redevelopment. In 2012 we will break ground on the new train station, begin to issue certificate of occupancy's for the first phase of rental units, begin the second phase of Avalon Bay's apartments and will welcome a third national developer, Pulte Homes, to begin construction of single family residences.

Most significantly, we will complete the purchase of the Assumption School and embark on transforming it into the New Wood-Ridge Intermediate School for grades 4, 5 and 6 which is scheduled to open in September 2013. In February we will have a public presentation on the renovation plans for the school, which are scheduled to begin in May. This transaction may be one of kind, public-private-not for profit partnership with the Borough, Bd. of Ed., Somerset Development, and the Archdiocese of Newark all teaming up to make this project become a reality and saving the taxpayers of WR millions of dollars over the next 15 years.

On a personal note, today I embark on my 4th full term as the Mayor of the Borough Wood-Ridge which will establish me as the longest serving Mayor in the history of the town. As I said earlier my personal life and this community has evolved in so many different ways since I first raised my hand to take the oath office as Mayor. Twelve years ago I was recently married had no children, never even imagined running for higher office let alone being the third highest ranking Democrat in the legislature, and I was working 15 hours a day and night out on the

Route 4 and 17 project as the onsite construction engineer. Taking over the reins of this town was the farthest thing from my mind.

Well 12 years later I can truly say it is has been a rewarding and fulfilling experience an obligation that weighs heavy on me every time a decision has to be made that impacts the residents of this town.

But my success has been a team effort

it is my wonderful Council that I spoke about earlier it is our Borough Officials, Department Heads, and volunteers who make my job as CEO of the town a pleasure. They always there to keep our residents safe, respond to their needs, and provide so many services and activities.

The success is because of our professionals not only are they the finest around, but their long terms of service to our community make them part of our extended Borough family. Especially Paul Barbire who has been with me from day one - 17 years as a counselor, mentor, confidant, father figure, and one of the best friends you could ever had.

The success is because of Chris Eilert one of the brightest and astute political and government minds in the state of NJ. He has been with me all 12 years as Mayor and all ten years in the legislature. My political career would not be what it is today if it wasn't for the insight, guidance, advice, tough love, friendship and hard work from Chris Eilert. Someday our town will lose Chris because of a higher calling, Councilman Marino, DiMarco and I comment all of the time over a beer

that the people of WR have no idea what a benefit Chris Eilert is to their community, safety, and the value of their homes.

Finally the success is due to a strong family that always sticks together through thick and thin. My Mom, Sister Diane, Brothers Charles and Tom, nieces Alyssa, Autumn Gianna, Nina, and Bella, nephews Stephen and Charlie, brother-in law Steve and sisters in law Michele and Nicole. They are all here supporting one another and I and we are all here because one man, one individual, one rock of strength and one leader kept us all on the right track and that is our Dad, Anthony Balbo Sarlo.

To my wife Connie and sons Anthony and Michael their love and support allows me to serve the public; it has been especially difficult for my wife over the last 12 years, but I pledge to do my best to make it all up. To my new found love of coaching every sport imaginable – Anthony and Michael when you are on the field I will be on the sideline.

Finally, I would like to thank the people of Wood-Ridge for their continued support and for allowing me to serve them in two capacities. I am truly honored for their annual confidence in me.
