Mayor Sarlo asked Coaches Jerry Cala, Bart Picheo, Dan Eckert and Ken Gardella to join him at the Dias to read the following and present Certificates to the U14 Wood-Ridge Blue Devils Soccer Team:

The U14 Girls Wood Ridge Blue Devils came into the 2016 season with high expectations. This was due to the success that the girls had in prior seasons. The roster was made up of 9 eighth graders and 5 seventh graders. The season began on a warm September night and ended on a frigid November night, three days before Thanksgiving. The Blue Devils finished the season with a perfect 13-0 record. The Blue Devils scored 48 goals while only allowing 9 goals. A very impressive 39 goal differential!

After defeating East Rutherford and Wallington in the playoffs, the Blue Devils advanced to the championship. In the final match, the Blue Devils faced arch rival Hasbrouck Heights. It was a hard fought match by both teams. It was a scoreless affair for most of the evening. With about 7 minutes remaining, the Blue Devils found the back of the net to secure a 1-0 victory. The U14 Girls Wood Ridge Blue Devils were crowned 2016 South Bergen Champions!!!!

**REPORTS OF GOVERNING BODY:**

Mayor Sarlo addressed the issue of the blue line that has been painted between double yellow lines on streets in many communities to show support for the police. He noted that many towns have painted the blue line on county roads, whereas Wood-Ridge did so on a portion of Union Avenue because it is a local road and is adjacent to the police station. He also noted that it was done by the contractor who was striping Union Avenue and other streets in town that were part of the 2016 road program, so there was no extra cost to the Borough for painting the blue line because this section of Union was being striped anyway.

Mayor Sarlo stated that recent newspaper articles have reported that the blue line may violate federal road safety regulations and that two NJ Congressmen were introducing legislation to make clear that the blue lines are permitted under the regulations. The Mayor directed the Borough Engineer and Borough Attorney to monitor the developments on this issue and to advise the governing body of same to determine if any action needs to be taken.

Councilman Azzolini gave an update for the Fire Department and EMS for the 2016 year. The fire department responded to 216 alarms of fire and 24 mutual aid alarms for a total of 3,452 hours of service. The EMS responded to 720 calls for a total of 6,851 man hours.

Councilwoman Cassidy announced the Historical Society would be holding a program on Irish Folk Tales on February 26, 2017.

Councilman Altamura reported that the Wood-Ridge Police attended a Criminal Justice Reform Class. He announced that the PBA, in conjunction with the Wood-Ridge Intermediate School, held a toy drive during the holidays for residents in need. He stated the Recreation Commission had their reorganization meeting and Dennis Brubaker was named President and Gerald Lanzerotti was named Vice-Chair. He also stated the borough website has received 11,870 visitors during the month of December.

Councilman Marino – no report

Councilman DiMarco stated the Planning Board has their reorganization meeting on January 12, 2017 and Frank Finke was named Chairman and Paul Clemente was named Vice-Chair. Councilman DiMarco also stated the Board of Health had their reorganization meeting on January 5, 2017 and Ed Schmidt was named President and Bob Keller was named Vice-President.

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Councilman Romero stated the Shade Tree had their reorganization meeting on January 9, 2017. He stated that 77 trees were planted last year and would be doing an inventory this year. Councilman Romero congratulated all the new members of the fire department.

**FIRST HEARING OF CITIZENS:**

Mayor Sarlo declared the Hearing of Citizens to be open. Anyone wishing to speak please come to the microphone in front of the room and state your name and address. Please speak clearly into the microphone.

John Wollerman of 63 Hill Street asked if something could be done about the dog waste on the grass areas adjacent to the 14<sup>th</sup> street field. Administrator Eilert stated he would begin by posting appropriate signs and see how that works before taking other action.

Corey Moore of 473 Windsor Road asked if there was a CAP on his property assessment. Mayor explained the opportunity available to all residents to discuss the appraisal from Appraisal Systems. Administrator Eilert explained that he may have been one of the homes that were not inspected and therefore a formula was used as opposed to an actual inspection. Mr. Moore asked if Wesmont Station was off-setting the taxes. Administrator Eilert explained that Wesmont Station was dramatically off-setting everyone's taxes. He explained that 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of the town are seeing a decrease because of the retables' at Wesmont. Mr. Moors asked if the tax rate of 2.45 included school, library and county taxes. Mr. Eilert stated yes and explained the process if he was unhappy with the outcome of his meeting with Appraisal Systems.

Glen Cinelli of 109 Columbia Street asked if something could be done with the parking situation on Columbia Street. He stated that he also received his assessment of \$820,000.00 but did not understand why his neighbors were allowed to park on the sidewalk. Mayor Sarlo agreed and stated that the matter would be looked in to more closely.

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Rich Martinelli of 216 Tenth Street asked the process after January if you do not get to speak to Appraisal Systems. Mayor Sarlo explained that homeowners have the right to appeal the appraisal with the County Tax Board.

Morris Sancilio of 467 Fritsch Avenue asked if the revaluation process could be explained again. Administrator Eilert explained the process from the receipt of the letter to the appeal process with the County Tax Board.
