BOND ORDINANCE NO. 2024-9

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO PARKS AND OPEN SPACE IN FURTHERANCE OF THE 2019 WESMONT STATION REDEVELOPMENT PLAN, IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$2,500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,500,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH TO FINANCE THE COST THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") designated certain parcels of real property, including the property referenced herein, as an area in need of redevelopment pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq.* (the "Redevelopment Law"); and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2019-4, the Mayor and Council of the Borough adopted and approved the 2019 Wesmont Station Redevelopment Plan (the "Redevelopment Plan"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Redevelopment Law, the Borough has elected to act as redevelopment entity (the "Redevelopment Entity") to implement the Redevelopment Plan and carry out the redevelopment project described therein, within the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Redevelopment Law provides that the Borough may incur indebtedness, borrow, appropriate and expend money and issue its negotiable bonds or other obligations for the purpose of aiding any redevelopment entity with respect to any redevelopment project which is located within its jurisdiction, including, those instances where, as here, the governing body of a municipality directly exercises the powers of the redevelopment entity under the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to exercise this authority to authorize bonds for purposes of various park improvements in furtherance of the Redevelopment Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals to this bond ordinance are hereby incorporated as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2. The improvement described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Wood-Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") as a general improvement. For the improvement or purpose described in Section 4(a), there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2,500,000, including a \$146,685 Bergen County Open Space Grant for Wood-Ridge Square Park and a \$63,000 Bergen County Open Space Grant for Bowman Park (collectively, the "Bergen County Open Space Grants"). No down payment is required pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-37(c)* as this bond ordinance authorizes obligations for the purpose of aiding the Redevelopment Entity with respect to the Redevelopment Project within the Borough.

Section 3. In order to finance the cost of the improvement or purpose and in anticipation of receipt of the Bergen County Open Space Grants, negotiable bonds are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$2,500,000 pursuant to the Redevelopment Law. In anticipation of the issuance of the bonds, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

Section 4. (a) The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued is various improvements to parks and open space in furtherance of the Redevelopment Plan, including, but not limited to, the construction of a new passive open park, landscaping, and the installation of lamps and benches at Wood-Ridge Square Park and the construction of pickball courts, the installation of a fence and sprinklers and the restoration of paths at Bowman Park and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

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(b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the improvement or purpose is as stated in Section 3 hereof.

(c) The estimated cost of the improvement or purpose is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefor.

Section 5. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer; provided that no bond anticipation note shall mature later than one year from its date, unless such bond anticipation notes are permitted to mature at such later date in accordance with applicable law. The bond anticipation notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the chief financial officer. The chief financial officer shall determine all matters in connection with bond anticipation notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the chief financial officer's signature upon the bond anticipation notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of the Redevelopment Law. The chief financial officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The chief financial officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 6. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 7. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The improvement or purpose described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance is not a current expense. It is an improvement or purpose that the Borough may lawfully undertake as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

(b) Pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-37(c)*, the obligations authorized herein shall mature in annual installments commencing not more than two and ending not more than forty years from their date of issuance.

(c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$2,500,000 but are deductible from gross debt pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:2-44(h)*, and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

(d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$400,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under *N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20* is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the purpose or improvement.

(e) The maximum rate of interest the bonds or bond anticipation notes shall bear is six percent (6.00%) per annum.

Section 8. The Borough hereby declares the intent of the Borough to issue bonds or bond anticipation notes in the amount authorized in Section 3 of this bond ordinance and to use the proceeds to pay or reimburse expenditures for the costs of the purposes described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance. This Section 8 is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of the Treasury Regulations.

Section 9. Any grant moneys received for the purpose described in Section 4(a) hereof shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvement or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

Section 10. The chief financial officer of the Borough is hereby authorized to prepare and to update from time to time as necessary a financial disclosure document to be distributed in connection with the sale of obligations of

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the Borough and to execute such disclosure document on behalf of the Borough. The chief financial officer is further authorized to enter into the appropriate undertaking to provide secondary market disclosure on behalf of the Borough pursuant to Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule") for the benefit of holders and beneficial owners of obligations of the Borough and to amend such undertaking from time to time in connection with any change in law, or interpretation thereof, provided such undertaking is and continues to be, in the opinion of a nationally recognized bond counsel, consistent with the requirements of the Rule. In the event that the Borough fails to comply with its undertaking, the Borough shall not be liable for any monetary damages, and the remedy shall be limited to specific performance of the undertaking.

Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall be obligated to levy *ad valorem* taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 12. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 513 SCHEDULE VIII, ENTITLED STOP INTERSECTIONS BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF INTERSECTIONS

SECTION 1.

A. § 513-50 Schedule VIII entitled Stop Intersections is hereby amended as follows:

Add the following intersections to the list of One-Way Stops:

Marshall Lane at Veterans Drive

Marshall Lane at Eleanor Drive

B. § 513-55 Schedule XIII entitled Parking Prohibited at All Times is hereby amended as follows:

1. Delete the following:

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ENTITLED BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Under Article 1, entitled Board of Health, Section 1 of Chapter 10 (§10-1) is hereby amended by replacing Subsections A, B, and C in their entirety as follows:

- A. Pursuant to P.L. 2023 c. 205, the Wood-Ridge Board of Health shall be comprised of the members of the Wood-Ridge Borough Council who shall possess all powers, exercise all authorities, perform all duties, and fulfill all responsibilities of the Board of Health as provided by law, regulation or ordinance.
- B. The Board of Health shall annually elect a President and Vice President, respectively, and shall hold its public meetings and conduct its public business either concurrently with a public meeting of the Mayor and Council or separately at a public meeting of the Board of Health, in which case, an official notice of said board meeting shall be issued.
- C. All Public Notices of a meeting of the Mayor and Council shall also constitute public notice of a meeting of the Board of Health. Any and all official actions of the Board of Health may be included on an agenda of, and conducted at, a meeting of the Mayor and Council, in which case, all such actions shall be recorded in the official minutes and ordinance books of the Mayor and Council.

SECTION 2. The entirety of Article II, entitled Local Assistance Board, inclusive of Sections 3 and 4 (§10-3 and §10-4), of Chapter 10, entitled Boards and Commissions, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The entirety of Article IV, entitled Shade Tree Commission, inclusive of Sections 9 through 14 (§10-9 through §10-14), of Chapter 10, entitled Boards and Commissions, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If any part, sections, provisions, or the total of any of the abovementioned publications are held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable in the State of New Jersey, that the balance and remainder of such publication shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-12

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW CHAPTER OF THE WOOD-RIDGE CODE TO BE NUMBERED 424 AND ENTITLED SALT STORAGE, PRIVATELY OWNED

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Establish a new Chapter 424 entitled Salt Storage, Privately Owned as follows

Chapter 424 Salt Storage, Privately Owned

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§ 424-1 Purpose

The purpose of this chapter is to prevent stored salt and other solid de-icing materials from being exposed to stormwater. This chapter establishes requirements for the storage of salt and other solid de-icing materials on properties not owned or operated by the municipality (privately-owned), including residences, in the Borough of Wood-Ridge to protect the environment, public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply.

§ 424-2 Definitions

For the purpose of this chapter, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this chapter clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When consistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

"De-icing materials" means any granular or solid material such as melting salt or any other granular solid that assists in the melting of snow.

"Impervious surface" means a surface that has been covered with a layer of material so that it is highly resistant to infiltration by water.

"Storm drain inlet" means the point of entry into the storm sewer system.

"Permanent structure" means a permanent building or permanent structure that is anchored to a permanent foundation with an impermeable floor, and that is completely roofed and walled (new structures require a door or other means of sealing the access way from wind driven rainfall). A fabric frame structure is a permanent structure if it meets the following specifications:

1. Concrete blocks, jersey barriers or other similar material shall be placed around the interior of the structure to protect the side walls during loading and unloading of de-icing materials;
2. The design shall prevent stormwater run-on and run through, and the fabric cannot leak;
3. The structure shall be erected on an impermeable slab;
4. The structure cannot be open sided; and
5. The structure shall have a roll up door or other means of sealing the access way from wind driven rainfall.

"Person" means any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of the State of New Jersey subject to municipal jurisdiction.

"Resident" means a person who resides on a residential property where de-icing material is stored.

§ 424-3 Deicing Material Storage Requirements

A. Temporary outdoor storage of de-icing materials in accordance with the requirements below is allowed between October 15th and April 15th:

1. Loose materials shall be placed on a flat, impervious surface in a manner that prevents stormwater run-through;
2. Loose materials shall be placed at least 50 feet from surface water bodies, storm drain inlets, ditches and/or other stormwater conveyance channels;

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3. Loose materials shall be maintained in a cone-shaped storage pile. If loading or unloading activities alter the cone-shape during daily activities, tracked materials shall be swept back into the storage pile, and the storage pile shall be reshaped into a cone after use;
4. Loose materials shall be covered as follows:
 - a. The cover shall be waterproof, impermeable, and flexible;
 - b. The cover shall extend to the base of the pile(s);
 - c. The cover shall be free from holes or tears;
 - d. The cover shall be secured and weighed down around the perimeter to prevent removal by wind; and
 - e. Weight shall be placed on the cover(s) in such a way that minimizes the potential of exposure as materials shift and runoff flows down to the base of the pile. Sandbags lashed together with rope or cable and placed uniformly over the flexible cover, or poly-cord nets provide a suitable method. Items that can potentially hold water (e.g., old tires) shall not be used;
5. Containers must be sealed when not in use; and
6. The site shall be free of all de-icing materials between April 16th and October 14th.

B. De-icing materials should be stored in a permanent structure if a suitable storage structure is available. For storage of loose de-icing materials in a permanent structure, such storage may be permanent, and thus not restricted to October 15 to April 15.

C. All structures, whether temporary or permanent, and all storage of deicing material must also comply with all other municipal ordinances and codes, including but not limited to those for buildings, construction, property maintenance, and zoning.

D. The property owner, or owner of the de-icing materials if different, shall designate a person(s) responsible for operations at the site where these materials are stored outdoors, and who shall document that weekly inspections are conducted to ensure that the conditions of this chapter are met. Inspection records shall be kept on site and made available to the municipality upon request. Residents who operate businesses from their homes that utilize de-icing materials are required to perform weekly inspections.

§ 424-4 Exemptions

Residents may store de-icing materials outside in a solid-walled, closed container that prevents precipitation from entering and exiting the container, and which prevents the deicing materials from leaking or spilling out. Under these circumstances, weekly inspections are not necessary, but repair or replacement of damaged or inadequate containers shall occur within 2 weeks.

If containerized (in bags or buckets) de-icing materials are stored within a permanent structure, they are not subject to the storage and inspection requirements in Section III above. Piles of de-icing materials are not exempt, even if stored in a permanent structure.

This chapter does not apply to facilities where the stormwater discharges from de-icing material storage activities are regulated under another NJPDES permit.

§ 424-5 Enforcement

This chapter shall be enforced by the property Maintenance Code Enforcement Officer of the Borough of Wood-Ridge and all Deputy, Assistant, and Special Assistant Property Maintenance Code Enforcement Officers during the course of ordinary enforcement duties.

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§ 424-6 Violations and Penalties

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this chapter shall have 72 hours to complete corrective action. Repeat violations and/or failure to complete corrective action shall be punishable as provided for by the General Borough Code in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article II, General Penalties. Each day that a violation shall continue shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any part, sections, provisions, or the total of any of the abovementioned publications are held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable in the State of New Jersey, that the balance and remainder of such publication shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 464, ENTITLED STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 464, entitled Stormwater Management, is hereby amended as follows:

- A. Under §468-13, entitled Scope and Purpose, under Part “C”, entitled Applicability, add a new number 3 as follows:
 - (3) Applicability of this Chapter to major developments shall comply with N.J.A.C. 7:8-1.6, including all amendments, which is hereby incorporated herein by reference.
- B. Amend §468-15, entitled Design and performance standards for stormwater management measures, as follows:
 - 1. Re-letter the existing Parts “A” and “B” as “B” and “C”, respectively.
 - 2. Establish a new Part “A” as follows:
 - A. Design and performance standards for stormwater management measures shall comply with N.J.A.C. 7:8-5, including all amendments, which is hereby incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any part, sections, provisions, or the total of any of the abovementioned publications are held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable in the State of New Jersey, that the balance and remainder of such publication shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF
GARFIELD FOR MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES.**

WHEREAS, an agreement providing for shared services among municipalities is permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. the “Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act”; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c) provides that two or more municipalities may agree to provide jointly for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and agree to appoint judges and administrators without establishing a joint municipal court; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1(c) further provides that where municipal courts share facilities, the identities of the individual courts shall continue to be expressed in the captions of orders and process; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to share municipal court services and to set forth the administrative and financial responsibilities of each party for the shared court services; and

WHEREAS, the shared court is subject to approval by the Administrative Offices of the Courts and the Vicinage Assignment Judge.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the promise’s covenants, terms and conditions set forth, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. This agreement shall be for three (3) years, beginning July 1, 2024 and terminate on June 30, 2027.
2. At any point in time, by written notice, either party may request an extension or renegotiation of the terms herein.
3. Garfield agrees to provide those facilities and services necessary for the operation of a Municipal Court including but not limited to a courtroom, chambers, office space, equipment, supplies and employees, to serve as Wood-Ridge’s Municipal Court.
4. The Municipal Courts shall share facilities, but the individual identities of the courts shall continue to be expressed in the caption orders and process.
5. Each municipality shall appoint their own judge, prosecutor, and public defender unless one or more said appointments are mutually agreed upon of said appointments.
6. Each municipality shall continue to appoint a Court Administrator, who shall be the existing Garfield Court Administrator and is hereby appointed by this resolution. It will be the responsibility of Garfield to ensure the Court Administrator is certified and attends/obtains required CEU’s.
7. Each municipal court shall continue to maintain its own docket and filings, which shall exist separately in the ATS/ACS database.
8. A complete set of financial records and separate reporting shall be maintained for each municipal court including any auditing requirements of the State of New Jersey or the Administrative Office of the Courts.
9. Wood-Ridge shall pay Garfield the following four (4) quarterly installments for leasing of space and professional staff payable on or around the 20th of July, October, January, and April. Annual payments shall be as follows:

\$95,000 in year 1, \$96,500 in year 2, and \$98,000 in year 3

10. Garfield shall order supplies for the operations of the Wood-Ridge court, including but not limited to ticket books, interpretation services, etc. and shall seek reimbursement from Wood-Ridge on a quarterly basis. Garfield shall submit invoices to Wood-Ridge on or around the first of the month of March, June, September, and December.
11. Revenue shall be distributed to each municipality based on each municipality's own filings.
12. Garfield Court shall coordinate with the Wood-Ridge Police Department to schedule hearings, proceedings, etc. to minimize overtime costs and to maintain a minimum staffing level as per the discretion of the Wood-Ridge Police Chief or his/her appointed designee. The Garfield Court will make every effort to coordinate with the Chief the schedule of the Court to ensure that Wood-Ridge residents receive maximum patrol as per the discretion of the Wood-Ridge Chief.
13. Wood-Ridge authorizes Garfield to choose a depository of funds that is convenient for its operations and said depository shall be dually appointed and copies of all relevant paperwork shall be given to Wood-Ridge.
14. Termination: Each municipality reserves the right to terminate this agreement. Termination must be done via Resolution of the Governing Body and provided no later than December 1 of the next court (calendar) year. In the event of criminal wrongdoing on the part of the Garfield court, Wood-Ridge may immediately terminate this agreement.
15. Future changes to this agreement may be done at the discretion of the Governing Bodies, by memorandums of understanding.
