**BOND ORDINANCE 2024-17**

**BOND ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING IN ITS ENTIRETY BOND ORDINANCE #2023-12, FINALLY ADOPTED NOVEMBER 1, 2023**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bond Ordinance #2023-12, finally adopted November 1, 2023, is hereby amended in its entirety to increase the appropriation amount, to include an additional grant and to include additional improvements and to read as follows:

“BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HIGHLAND AVENUE LEARNING ANNEX AND RECREATION CENTER, ACQUISITION OF REAL ESTATE, AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS TO BUILDINGS AND PROPERTY IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$45,000,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$20,000,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") designated certain parcels of real property, including the property referenced herein, as an area in need of redevelopment pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq.* (the "Redevelopment Law"); and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2019-4, the Mayor and Council of the Borough adopted and approved the 2019 Wesmont Station Redevelopment Plan (the "Redevelopment Plan"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Redevelopment Law, the Borough has elected to act as redevelopment entity (the "Redevelopment Entity") to implement the Redevelopment Plan and carry out the redevelopment projects described therein, within the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, Section 37 of the Redevelopment Law provides that the Borough may incur indebtedness, borrow, appropriate and expend money and issue its negotiable bonds or other obligations for the purpose of aiding any redevelopment entity with respect to any redevelopment project which is located within its jurisdiction, including, those instances where, as here, the governing body of a municipality directly exercises the powers of the redevelopment entity under the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to exercise this authority to authorize bonds to provide for the construction of the Highland Avenue Learning Annex and Recreation Center, the acquisition of real estate, and the improvement of buildings and property in furtherance of the Redevelopment Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals to this bond ordinance are hereby incorporated as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2. The improvements described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough as general improvements. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 4(a), there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$45,000,000, including a \$12,500,000 State of New Jersey FY2024 Appropriations Act grant and a \$12,500,000 State of New Jersey FY2025 Appropriations Act grant, both issued through the State Department of Education (together, the "State Grants"), awarded to the Wood-Ridge Board of Education (the "School District") and contributed to the Borough pursuant to the terms of Shared Services Agreements dated June 21, 2023 and September 1, 2024, respectively (together, the "Shared Services Agreements") by and between the Borough and the School District. Said State Grants shall be used in furtherance of the purposes described in Subsection "i." of Section 4(a) only. No down payment is required on the amount of the appropriation not funded by the State Grants pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-37(c) as this bond ordinance authorizes obligations for the purpose of aiding the Redevelopment Entity with respect to the hereinafter defined Redevelopment Project within the Borough.

Section 3. In order to finance the cost of the improvements or purposes not covered by application of the State Grants, negotiable bonds are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$20,000,000 pursuant to the Redevelopment Law. In anticipation of the issuance of the bonds, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

Section 4. (a) The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued are as follows (collectively, and as more fully set forth in the Redevelopment Plan, the "Redevelopment Project"):

- i. The construction of the Highland Avenue Learning Annex and Recreation Center, as well as renovations to the existing Doyle Elementary School building and property, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.
- ii. Acquisition of real estate known as Block 290, Lot 1 on the Borough of Wood-Ridge Tax Map and further identified as 288 Highland Avenue ("Real Estate") as authorized by Borough Ordinance 2024-7, finally adopted April 17, 2024, pursuant to the Local Lands and Buildings Law *N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq.*, which shall include the demolition of all structures thereon and the undertaking of all improvements necessary to utilize said Real Estate in support and future benefit of the Doyle Elementary School and Highland Avenue Learning Annex and Recreation Center to which said real estate is adjacent and contiguous, as well as all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.
- iii. Improvements and renovations to the Wood-Ridge Intermediate School building and property, which is owned by the Borough, and the Wood-Ridge High School building and property, which is owned by the School District, pursuant to the Shared Service Agreements, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.
- iv. Improvements to the Wood-Ridge Athletic Complex, which is owned by the Borough and located in the Redevelopment Area, which shall include the construction of athletic fields, pickleball courts, parking lots, and other public amenities including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

(b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or bond anticipation notes to be issued for the improvements or purposes is as stated in Section 3 hereof.

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(c) The estimated cost of the improvements or purposes is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefor:

Section 5. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer; provided that no bond anticipation note shall mature later than one year from its date, unless such bond anticipation notes are permitted to mature at such later date in accordance with applicable law. The bond anticipation notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the chief financial officer. The chief financial officer shall determine all matters in connection with bond anticipation notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the chief financial officer's signature upon the bond anticipation notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of the Redevelopment Law. The chief financial officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the bond anticipation notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The chief financial officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the bond anticipation notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the bond anticipation notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 6. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 7. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The improvements or purposes described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance are not current expenses. They are improvements or purposes that the Borough may lawfully undertake as improvements described in the Redevelopment Plan, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

(b) Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-37(c), the obligations authorized herein shall mature in annual installments commencing not more than two and ending not more than thirty years from their date of issuance.

(c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$20,000,000, and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by that Law.

(d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$2,500,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the purposes or improvements.

(e) The obligations of the Borough authorized by this bond ordinance shall bear interest at a maximum rate of not to exceed six per centum (6.00%) per annum.

Section 8. Any grant moneys received for the purposes described in Section 4(a) hereof shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvement or, if other than the State Grants referred to in Section 2 hereof, to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized but not issued hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

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Section 9. The Borough hereby declares the intent of the Borough to issue the bonds or bond anticipation notes in the amount authorized in Section 3 of this bond ordinance and to use proceeds to pay or reimburse expenditures for the costs of the purposes or improvements described in Section 4(a) of this bond ordinance. This Section 9 is a declaration of intent within the meaning and for purposes of Treasury Regulations §1.150-2 or any successor provisions of federal income tax law.

Section 10. The chief financial officer of the Borough is hereby authorized to prepare and to update from time to time as necessary a financial disclosure document to be distributed in connection with the sale of obligations of the Borough and to execute such disclosure document on behalf of the Borough. The chief financial officer is further authorized to enter into the appropriate undertaking to provide secondary market disclosure on behalf of the Borough pursuant to Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Rule") for the benefit of holders and beneficial owners of obligations of the Borough and to amend such undertaking from time to time in connection with any change in law, or interpretation thereof, provided such undertaking is and continues to be, in the opinion of a nationally recognized bond counsel, consistent with the requirements of the Rule. In the event that the Borough fails to comply with its undertaking, the Borough shall not be liable for any monetary damages, and the remedy shall be limited to specific performance of the undertaking.

Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall be obligated to levy *ad valorem* taxes upon all the taxable property within the Borough for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 12. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption."

Section Two. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Wood-Ridge, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Borough, including all work, materials, equipment and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor: (A) improvements to public buildings and property, including, but not limited to, upgrading of computer, communication and security systems; and (B) acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, for the use of various Borough departments, offices and agencies.

Section 2. The sum of \$5,000,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law") and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$5,000,000, and (4) \$250,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose; and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$4,750,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$500,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$250,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for the Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$250,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$4,750,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

*Minutes of the 1915<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting of November 13, 2024*

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$4,750,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance, and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of five years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$4,750,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

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**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-19**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF THE REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS BLOCK 314, LOT 20, (505 MARLBORO ROAD), BLOCK 314, LOT 14, (VACANT LAND ON MARLBORO ROAD), AND BLOCK 314, LOT 19, (261 HACKENSACK STREET) ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF WOOD-RIDGE BY PURCHASE OR, IF NECESSARY, EMINENT DOMAIN.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq., the Borough has the power to acquire real property for a public purpose through negotiated agreement or by the exercise of its powers of eminent domain; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough desires to acquire the property known as Block 314, Lot 20, 505 Marlboro Road, Block 314, Lot 14, vacant land on Marlboro Road, and Block 314, Lot 19, 261 Hackensack Street, hereinafter "Property", which are located in the Hackensack Street Business District and are in close proximity to Public Facilities including the Borough's High School, Athletic Field, Library, Senior Center and Civic Center, in order to expand the open space available for green spaces, streetscapes, parking and other public uses in the Borough for the use and enjoyment of the local population; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has determined that it is necessary, beneficial and in the public interest to acquire the Property for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, the acquisition of such property to be utilized for parking and other public uses will fulfill a Master Plan goal of the Borough with regard to providing for green spaces, streetscapes and necessary parking facilities in the vicinity of the Hackensack Street Business District; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that:

**SECTION 1.** The Borough of Wood-Ridge be and is hereby authorized to acquire, by negotiation, contract of purchase or, if necessary, by the exercise of its power of eminent domain pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-5 and N.J.S.A. 20:3-1 et seq., certain lands and/or any and all interests in the Property for the purposes described hereinabove or such other public purposes deemed appropriate by the Borough and take such other actions necessary to take title and possession of the Property; and

**SECTION 2.** Special counsel Gerald R. Salerno, Esq. and Borough Administrator Christopher W. Eilert are hereby authorized to hire and employ such appraisers, consultants, and experts as may be appropriate to effectuate such acquisitions, whether by negotiation or eminent domain proceedings, and to pay said consultants and experts a reasonable fee for their services; and

**SECTION 3.** The amount to be offered by the Borough to the record owner of the Property pursuant to N.J.S.A. 20:3-6 shall be fixed by further resolution of the Borough upon receipt and approval of an appraisal reports prepared on behalf of the Borough by a qualified licensed real estate appraiser and which offer shall also address any rights and/or remedies the Borough may have to any unpaid taxes, escrow funds for, and/or recover the costs of, any environmental remediation and/or clean-up required in accordance will all

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applicable laws that have been incurred, or may be incurred in the future, by the Borough due to environmental conditions in existence on the Property on and/or before the date of vesting of title and possession of the Property in the name of the Borough; and

**SECTION 4.** Mayor Paul A. Sarlo, Special counsel Gerald R. Salerno, Esq. and Borough Administrator Christopher W. Eilert are hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to acquire the Property and/or any interests thereto, either through negotiation or, if necessary, the exercise of the Borough's power of eminent domain; and

**SECTION 5.** Mayor Paul A. Sarlo and Borough Clerk Gina Affuso are hereby authorized to execute and witness any documents or instruments necessary to acquire the Property and/or any interests thereto; and

**SECTION 6.** If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section, or provision shall be severable from the balance of this Ordinance and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect; and

**SECTION 7.** If any ordinances or parts thereof are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, such ordinances or parts thereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

**SECTION 8.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.

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**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-20**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XVIII OF CHAPTER 100, ENTITLED HOUSING LIAISON**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Article XVIII of Chapter 100, entitled Housing Liaison, is hereby amended by replacing it in its entirety as follows:

**Article XVIII Municipal Housing Liaison**

**§ 100-37 Purpose.**

The purpose of this article is to create the administrative mechanisms needed for the execution of the Borough of Wood-Ridge's responsibility to assist in the provision of affordable housing pursuant to the Fair Housing Act of 1985 and its subsequent amendments.

**§ 100-38 Definitions.**

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**ADMINISTRATIVE AGENT**

The person or entity appointed or contracted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge who shall be responsible for administering the affordability controls of some or all units in the Affordable Housing Program for the Borough of Wood-Ridge to ensure that the restricted

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units under administration are affirmatively marketed and sold or rented, as applicable, only to households that meet the applicable eligibility criteria.

**MUNICIPAL HOUSING LIAISON**

The employee charged by the governing body with the responsibility for oversight and administration of the Affordable Housing Program for the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

**§ 100-39 Establishment of Municipal Housing Liaison position and compensation; powers and duties.**

- A. Establishment of position of Municipal Housing Liaison. There is hereby established the position of Municipal Housing Liaison for the Borough of Wood-Ridge.
- B. The Municipal Housing Liaison shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Borough Council, be a full-time or part-time employee of the Borough reporting to the Borough Administrator, receive such compensation as established by the annual salary ordinance, and be subject to all rules and policies of the Employee Handbook.
- C. The Municipal Housing Liaison shall:
  - 1. Be responsible for oversight and administration of the Affordable Housing Program for the Borough of Wood-Ridge
  - 2. Possess all powers and authorities as provided for by the laws and regulations of the State of New Jersey
  - 3. Perform all duties as required by the laws and regulations of the State of New Jersey
  - 4. Monitor any and all Administrative Agents within the Borough's jurisdiction
  - 5. Be assisted in performing their duties by other employees and professionals of the Borough as directed by the Borough Administrator

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** If any subchapter, section, subsection, part, provision, or the total of any of the abovementioned publications are held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court, the findings or judgments of which court are applicable in the State of New Jersey, that the balance and remainder of such publication shall remain in full force and effect as an Ordinance of the Borough of Wood-Ridge.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH COUNTY OF BERGEN  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION OF COMMUNICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen ("County"), through its Department of Public Safety Division of Communications, currently operates a state-of-the-art Public Safety Operations Center, providing 9-1-1 communications and dispatch services to municipalities throughout Bergen County; and

WHEREAS, the County utilizes a Digital Trunked Radio System designed at industry standards to provide 95% portable in-street, on-hip coverage and reliability throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wood-Ridge ("Municipality") wishes to utilize the County's Digital Trunked Radio System for police, fire, and/or EMS communications; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has, with cooperation from the County, tested its coverage area, including outdoor and indoor locations, to ensure that the Countywide Digital Trunked Radio System provides adequate coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality either possesses or will procure any equipment necessary to utilize the Digital Trunked Radio System; and

WHEREAS, the County has sufficient system capacity to permit Municipality to utilize the Digital Trunked Radio System; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality and the County wish to enter into a shared services agreement ("Shared Services Agreement") whereby the Municipality shall be permitted to connect Municipality's radio units to the County's Digital Trunked Radio System, and utilize same for police, fire, and/or EMS communication purposes; and

WHEREAS, by utilizing the County's Digital Trunked Radio System, the Municipality will avoid the need to invest capital resources in the purchase and maintenance of its own standalone radio infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality's sharing of the Digital Trunked Radio System will facilitate cross-agency radio communication in the event of inter-municipal or regional emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.) promotes the broad use of shared services as a technique to reduce local expenses funded by property taxpayers; and

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WHEREAS, the Municipality has agreed to the terms of the Shared Services Agreement by adoption of Resolution No.0750-24, adopted July 3, 2024, a copy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:41A-36(i), Bergen County Executive James J. Tedesco, III, has presented the Shared Services Agreement to the Board of County Commissioners for its review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bergen County Board of COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, upon the recommendation of Ralph Rivera, Director of Public Safety, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 230 of the Code of the Borough of Wood-Ridge in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.3 authorizes the public officer whenever it appears that any building is unfit for human habitation or occupancy

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or use, to serve upon the owner and any parties in interest in such building a complaint and notice for a hearing to be conducted to determine if such building should be demolished; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that the Public Officer is hereby authorized to proceed in accordance with Chapter 230 of the Code of the Borough of Wood-Ridge and N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.3 to take such steps as are necessary to issue a complaint and conduct a hearing regarding the demolition of the building located at 148 12th Street, in the Borough of Wood-Ridge, in accordance with the Conclusions and Recommendations set forth in the report prepared by Titan Engineers PC on file in the Building Department, and be it further; and be it further

**RESOLVED BE IT FURTHER**, Gerald R. Salerno, Esq. is hereby authorized as special counsel to the Borough to proceed with due diligence to take any steps legally necessary or required to assist the public officer in conducting said hearing seeking the demolition and removal of the structure including removal of the foundation, located at 148 12th Street, in the Borough of Wood-Ridge.
