Since there was no further business to come before the Council, Councilperson Romero, seconded by Councilperson Donato moved for adjournment. By unanimous vote of the members of the Council present, the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wood-Ridge held on December 17, 2025 was duly adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
