Distribution of flyers to the Moonachie Schools was also discussed. Ms. Kinsella will discuss the distribution of flyers with the MAA and get back to the Recreation Commission if there are to be any changes. Jacki Goldklang will send Ms. Kinsella a copy of the January minutes.

Brian Hansen was in attendance on behalf of Girls Recreation Softball. Brian mentioned that he has offered Moonachie to participate in the Wood Ridge Program. Moonachie girls would then be a part of our program and included in our draft.

Kendal Garvin was in attendance as a parent of an 8th grade basketball player on the South Bergen Travel team. Kendal wanted to know why the South Bergen League was not a cut team. Dennis Brubaker explained that the South Bergen Teams original concept was a recreation travel program almost like an all star program. Recreation pays referee and league fees. There is a no cut policy. South Bergen can go out on their own if they choose but this must be something that they discuss with their board.

Trevor from Field of Dreams Baseball Training Facility was in attendance to discuss his new indoor facility.

Discussed wrestling medical incident and doctor's release. Ed Rendzio called me with an interest in running the recreation basketball program if we need someone in the future. Liaisons will remain the same for the 2009 program with one modification. Jerry Lanzerotti will be added to soccer with Emil Bevacqua as co-liaisons.
