John Gingerelli made a motion to purchase a tarp for the WRHS Field (Rec Other). The motion was seconded by Emil Bevacqua. Vote was taken. All ayes, motion passed.

Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Wrestling had various accomplishments this year. Will attend the next wrestling meeting and discuss the registration of Evan Deluise and the balance due on the LaReggia end of year bill. Reported that as a result of an issue with Babe Ruth Baseball, Ken Macri was suspended for two games. Reminded everyone that Parents too need to be held accountable for their actions as described in our Parent Code of Ethics.

- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Track and Field numbers are good (69). First meet was held in Saddle Brook and we had approximately 30 kids participate.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Girls Softball going well. Little League CPR course was held which included instructions on use of the AED. Course was excellent (\$25 per coach).
- d. **Emil Bevacqua:** Soccer would like to impose of late registration fee (see new business below). Sport Squirts and Soccer Squirts will be held at the Union Avenue Field Mondays and Thursdays April 25th (1-2 p.m., 12:15-1:15 p.m.)
- e. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Not in attendance.
- f. **Bryon Parisi:** - Not in attendance.
- g. **Ezio Altamura:** Tuesday May 17th the Mayor & Council would like to honor Dennis Brubaker, Joe Zielinski and Jimmy Catrillo for their years of service. Phil Romero will email Jacki the specific information on Jimmy and Jacki will forward to Ezio Altamura. Jacki will email Joe. Requested that Jacki send a letter to Henry von der Osten re: Senior Club Status. No update with Assumption School. Train station at Westmont may need to be moved because of safety reasons. Looking into the possibility of a floating platform. Civic Center project is currently on hold as a result of changes made by the architect that have not been approved and need to be revisited.

Motion was seconded by Jerry Lanzerotti. Vote was taken, all ayes. As in the past Summer Recreation Counselors will first be chosen from the pool of volunteers from the previous summer.

New Business:

Soccer would like to set a late registration fee of \$25 per person. Following a lengthy discussion and because the economy is still difficult for many the recreation commission voted to deny the request at this time. *Motion was made by Jerry Lanzerotti to deny a late registration fee at this time. Motion was seconded by Emil Bevacqua. Vote was taken, all ayes.*
