- g. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Not in attendance.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:** Introduced new commission member Tony Sartori who will take the place of Emil Bevacqua beginning January 2012. Met with Brian Hansen, John Wollerman, Bob Newsome, at the Union Avenue Field to discuss problems. New bean clay and all repairs will be completed by the spring 2012. Would like the Recreation Commission bylaws to be reviewed as a goal for 2012. Assumption School is moving along. Currently the goal is to be open for the 2013 school year.
- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Received a call from Rich Pronti who wanted to discuss Girls Softball Scholarships as well as opening up the program to Carlstadt and Lyndhurst. Commission was ok with both. Stretch the Sillyman will perform at the Fiesta breakfast sponsored by the PTA. Moonachie money (\$5000) is in and was applied to the groups that receive it. Budget money will be in before the end of the year. As a result of the construction, the Civic Center schedule was cleared from 12/17 through the first week of the New Year. No events were cancelled; all were moved to the Senior Center. Holiday Lights Tour will be held on December 18<sup>th</sup>. Registrations: Girls Softball very low, Babe Ruth very low, Track and Field to begin after the New Year, Wrestling is at 45, and Basketball is at 210. Reorganization meeting for recreation will be held on January 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. Currently collecting 2012 Budgets. So far Wrestling and Babe Ruth have been received. Bank statements for Soccer are in. WRHS to host a luncheon on December 16<sup>th</sup> for the seniors at the senior center. Senior scam presentation hosted by Arbor Glenn will be held on 12/19. Extra shopping trip for seniors on 12/20. Problem with the soccer vouchers that we received for the \$1380 that was give to Jonathan Braid to pay the referees. DPW mentioned that the 14<sup>th</sup> Street field had not been shut down for the winter. All issues have since been completed. Mentioned a wrestling practice room be considered as part of the Assumption School renovations.
