The girls played in Moonachie for the South Bergen Travel Program and they registered in Wood Ridge for the Recreation Program. The Recreation Commission did not see a conflict and through that the girls might be able to do both. The Recreation Commission agreed that if Moonachie wants Wood Ridge to refuse their children for any sport, they must put it in writing. The Recreation Commission suggested that Rhonda reach out the Ed Rendzio to see if some of our 7th and 8th grade girls might want to play on their South Bergen Team, because we do not have a team in South Bergen at that level. The Recreation Commission also suggested that Rhonda speak to Ed Rendzio about plans for next season.

Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** A plaque dedicating the new built in trophy case at the civic center will be created in honor of past Recreation Commission member John Slattery. Civic Center looks great. Chris plans to have a meeting with all of the groups before they are allowed back in to go over rules and regulations for using the building.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Indoor Soccer for grades K through 2 has begun at ICHS. Nick is on top of things. A meeting will be held February 16th to elect a Track & Field Board and go over the program with parents. Met with New Jersey Striders about the upcoming season.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Girls Softball Board questioned whether or not we can charge a late fee for late registrations. Jacki mentioned that quite often the registration is late because they don't have the money and that may keep

children from registering. Work will be done to improve the Union Avenue Field. The kick-off parade is set for April 7th. WRHS Competitive Cheering will host their Annual Cheer Competition on February 18th.

- f. **Barbara Fischkelta:** No Basketball meeting this month. Program opened up on January 7th. Pictures were taken.

- h. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Budgets were received from all groups except Basketball, Girls Softball and Soccer. All invoices received in January will not be processed until the borough we receive the go ahead from borough hall. Two injuries occurred this month. Evan Duran was injured in wrestling. Kristin Perruci was injured in competitive cheering. Registrations for spring sports continue to come in slowly. Mike Carcich (WRHS Varsity Baseball Coach) will once again hold a baseball camp during spring break week at WRHS. YMCA requested to use the Civic Center for the last two weeks of August for their summer camp. The children would be out of the building most days but would be dropped off at 7:30 a.m. and picked up at 6 p.m. each day. This would directly interfere with cheering practices which are Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the summer as well as WRHS Band Camp. WRHS uses the Civic Center as a rain facility for band camp.
