Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Coaches Certification is scheduled for Monday March 26th for spring sports. Memorial Day Parade meeting will be held on March 19th. Each group will be represented seasonally.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Track and Field is up to 47 participants. First practice will be held weather permitting on March 19th.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Little League parade will be held on Saturday April 7th. Girls Softball may not march due to spring break week and many families going away. Jr. Football and Cheering will hold their meeting on Monday March 19th.
- d. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Rich Pronti would like to offer two scholarships to graduating senior on behalf of Adult Softball.
- e. **Bryon Parisi:** Wrestling will hold their end of season awards at the Fiesta.
- f. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Soccer board held a meeting and elections were finalized. Basketball will hold a final meeting. The program ran much better this year than last. Travel program, 8th graders are still in the playoffs.
- g. **Tony Sartori:** Spoke to Mike Carcich. Put his Baseball Camp brochure through Little League. Will meet with Jacki to go over camp schedule.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:** Gave a brief update of progress with Westmont and Civic Center construction project. Recreation budget for 2012 is \$58,000. Jacki will confirm with Chris. Questioned when we were planning to honor Emil.
- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Registration for Fall Sports will begin in April. All groups that regularly use the Civic Center and Senior Center are being rescheduled to use the Borough Hall facilities and the Assumption School when necessary.

New Business:

A motion was made by John Gingerelli to set the 2012 registration fees as follows:

Girl's Softball \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Track and Field \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Babe Ruth Baseball \$75 per child or \$100 per two or more siblings

Jr. Football & Cheering \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Fall Soccer \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Wrestling \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Indoor Soccer \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Basketball \$50 per child or \$75 per two or more siblings

Summer Recreation \$110 per child and \$70 for each additional sibling (\$110 for one child, \$180 for two children, \$250 for three children, \$320 for four children etc. There is also a \$50 late fee per child for any late registration received for Summer Recreation.

The motion was seconded by Toniann Azzolini. A vote was taken, all ayes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by John Gingerelli to update the Parent's Code of Ethics with the following:

"As a Coach, Parent or Board Member, I will not disseminate any information or opinion through mail, email, or any form of media that will criticize the actions of a coach, player, parent, or Board Member, or the program in general. If I have a grievance, I will bring it to the Board of Officers of the particular group and if not satisfied, I may appeal to the Wood Ridge Recreation Commission. I understand this does not prohibit the use of such media to alert other members to attend the next Board meeting, but such media shall contain only a vague reference to the grievance involved and shall not be specific."

The motion was seconded by Toniann Azzolini. A vote was taken, all ayes. Motion passed.
