A motion was made by John Gingerelli and seconded by Toni Ann Azzolini to approve the above bills; vote taken; all ayes, Motion passed.

Hearing of Citizens:

Luke Incognito and Russ DeRobertis were in attendance on behalf of Jr. Football and Cheering. Dennis briefly reported on the meeting that was held with Jr. Football and Cheering. Attendees were Dennis Brubaker, John Gingerelli, Jack Goldklang, Luke Incognito, Amy Christianna, Ezio Altamura and Russ DeRobertis. Luke was unaware that he was supposed to forward monthly copies of the Friends of Account to Jacki Goldklang. There was a misunderstanding with the ordering of equipment and the vendor. Luke was under the impression he would be receiving a \$1,000 credit for merchandise. Rawlings did have a Pick Six Program. If you bought 12 Rawlings helmets and 12 Rawlings shoulder pads along with \$6,000 in additional Rawlings merchandize, you would earn 900 points that you could use to purchase merchandise. (Jr. Football has since picked out 13 pair of shoulder pads and 1 football with their points) Jr. Football and Cheering will forward copies of their monthly statements to Jacki and will have copies of their books available at their monthly meeting for both the Borough and Friends of Accounts. Jr. Football/Cheering overspent in 2012 and will need additional funding from the Recreation Commission. A closed session meeting was held to discuss. Recreation will cover the bills for 2012 (\$12,750 instead of the \$8,000 they were supposed to receive) but instructed Jr. Football on the procedure for purchasing and encouraged them to stick to their budget for next year. The borough will not give Jr. Football any additional money in 2012. All future expenses for the 2012 season will be the responsibility of the Jr. Football Cheering Program. This includes end of year and officials fees as well.

Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Coaches Certification will be held on October 22nd for Winter sports.

- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Soccer was really great under the lights. They are very appreciative for the turf field.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** See Hearing of Citizens above.
- d. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Adult Softball going well. They would like to be considered for additional time on the turf if available next fall. Ragamuffin parade on track.
- e. **Bryon Parisi:** Nothing to report. Jacki reported that Wrestling had their practice schedule and three tournament dates set. Registration is available through October 31st. They submitted their coaches lists which were verified and those that required certification were notified.
- f. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Basketball had a start up meeting. Registration has begun for the recreation program and will end on October 31st.
- g. **Tony Sartori:** Nothing to report.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:** Thanked everyone for their participation and support of the Mayor's 5k Race. Fire engine rides were held on October 14th and were a real treat for anyone that participated. Senior Citizen Halloween Costume Party will be held on October 26th. Holiday Tree Lighting will be held on the day after Thanksgiving. December 7th is the Mayor's Holiday Pasta Dinner.
- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Girls Softball will resume meeting in November. Ragamuffin Parade will need additional funding this year to include the D.J. We need people to work at the Recreation table. The 2012 Budget Breakdown is ready to be submitted to the Mayor, Council and Borough Administrator. An adjustment will be made to reflect the change for the additional funding for Jr. Football and it will be resubmitted. Jr. Football injuries (Gabe Suarez, Coach Carey Piret, Ryan Kriegel, Nick Fugnitti, Kevin Castillo, Christian Leone, Isabella Albanese, Jacob Feliciano). Adult Softball injury (Larry Timpson). Bracelets to support the WR Memorial Scholarship Fund in memory of Matthew Killen will be sold at various recreation events. Joe Lopardo will get in touch with Jonathan Braid and Luke Incognito to make arrangements. Dawn Lau Dance will like to once again use our facility for classes. Recreation Commission is ok as long as it does not interfere with any other town program.
