Hearing of Citizens:

Raymond Kalafsky was in attendance. He is a 1980 graduate of WRHS . He has coached Little League for 3 years and has helped with Basketball for the past two years. He volunteers with the Passaic Police with underprivileged kids. He had a problem with Jr. Football as a result of an incident that took place on October 18th between his son and another football player on the team causing him to be banned from practices and games. As a result of Mr. Kalafsky's violation of the Wood Ridge Parent Code of Ethics, the Recreation Commission voted at their November meeting to preclude him from consideration for winter coaching (basketball). He received in writing from Jr. Football that if he respected their decision, they would take no further action. He apologized for his actions and requested that the vote to not allow him to coach basketball be reconsidered. *A motion was made by John Gingerelli to allow Mr. Kalafsky to be considered for coaching Basketball as long as he was fingerprinted and certified. The motion was seconded by Bryon Parisi and the vote taken was all ayes. Motion passed.*

Robert McMullin was in attendance. He has known Mr. Kalafsky for many years and had many nice things to say about Mr. Kalafsky. He would not hesitate to allow him to coach his son.

June Colon and Tracy Milne were in attendance to question changes that Jr. Football/Cheering has proposed to their bylaws. They had some complaints about and questions about bylaw amendments.
