Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Coaches Certification for Fall Sports is scheduled to be held on Tuesday June 4th.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Track & Field has 71 participants. Meet will be held in Saddlebrook on April 14th.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Little League and Girl's Softball are both doing well.
- d. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Nothing to report.

- e. **Bryon Parisi:** Wrestling held their end of season awards on April 5th. They are currently collecting singlets.
- f. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Nothing to report.
- g. **Tony Sartori:** Submitted via email. Babe Ruth Baseball held their draft with no issues resulting. All three Wood Ridge teams won their season openers. Many coaches need to complete various training and as a result many are not eligible to coach. Coach Carcich held his Spring MVP Camp with 55 campers (most ever). No issues were reported. Attended the last day, kids seemed to be organized and having a great time. U.S. Sports has low registration for their spring camp. Jacki sent the brochures to Presbyterian in an effort to boost enrollment. Blue Devil Summer Basketball Camp has finalized the first week and is working on the second (conflict with volleyball camp). Reached out to Luke in reference to the Football Camp and has not yet received a response. Will follow-up. Lastly, attended two High School Baseball games in the past week. Girl's softball is not waiting for the teams to exit the WRHS turf field and has created dangerous situations as a result. These issues need to be addressed.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:** WRHS Turf Field pitchers mound and home plate have been refurbished. The borough will be acquiring the parking lot and attached grass that is across the street from the Civic Center.
- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Distributed copies of the current Soccer Bylaws, Jr. Football Bylaws and Basketball Bylaws (sent copies to Rich Domanski to update the borough site as well). Emailed the recreation groups for their 2013 Budget Requests and Friends of Account Documentation. (received Babe Ruth, Track & Field, & Football/Cheering) This is the first time that we have actually deemed coaches ineligible to coach as a result of not complying with requirements. All coaches are eligible for Track & Field and Girls Softball. Babe Ruth Baseball still has six coaches that are not eligible to coach. (Tony Belgiovine, Kevin Trotter, Anthony Trano, Cesar Guerra, Michael Lia, Chris Menge) Memorial Day Parade letter sent to all of the Recreation Groups. Porto John has been ordered. Track & Field has responded and will be in attendance. Six applications were received for the Summer Recreation volunteers. ***A motion was made by Barbara Fischkelta, seconded by Jerry Lanzerotti to accept all six volunteers for the 2013 program. Vote taken; all ayes. Motion passed.*** Jacki requested that Ed Rendzio's salary for the 2013 Summer Recreation Program be set at \$410 per week. ***A motion was made by John Gingerelli and seconded by Jerry Lanzerotti to set the salary for Ed Rendzio, Athletic Director for the 2013 Program at \$410. Vote taken; all ayes. Motion Passed.*** Ed Rendzio would like to hold open gym for boys and girls in grades 7 through 12 on Tuesdays and Thursdays from April 18th through June 6th with the following

stipulations. 1. Only Wood Ridge and Moonachie boys and girls can participate, 2. Only boys and girls that actually play basketball can participate (not a hang out), 3. The program must be canceled any night that adult supervision is not available, 4. A list of the adult supervisors must be submitted and all must be certified coaches that have had background checks and have viewed the concussion video, 5. Each participant must have a parent/guardian sign a waiver (provided) that will be kept on file at the recreation office, 6. A weekly attendance or sign in sheet must be kept by the supervisors/coaches, 7. The participants must be instructed that obligations to their spring sport must come first. ***A motion was made by Jerry Lanzerotti, seconded by Barbara Fischkelta to allow the 7th – 12th grade open basketball to be held at the WRHS Gym on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m. beginning April 18th through June 6th with the 7 stipulations listed above. A vote was take; all ayes. Motion Passed.***
