### Hearing of Citizens:

**Rick Reiter** was in attendance to report that the new soccer board for 2014 is in place (Rick Reiter – President, Mark Peck – Head Coach, Todd Muoio – Coach, Dan Rella – Vice President, Ben Cappello – Secretary, Franco Gentile – Treasurer. Rick apologized for submitting the 2013 budget request late.

**Frank Matera** was in attendance to discuss AED training. (Automatic External Difibrilator) The purpose of the AED is to stop the heart so that it can go back into a normal rhythm. Wood Ridge EMS can do the training. Cost is \$40 per person. The course would include CPR and AED (6 hrs). The course is good for two years. Instructions is included for Adults, Children and Infants and choking victims as well. Class size is limited to six per instructor. A refresher course is available and is 3.5 to 4 hrs. Jacki asked if there was a Basic First Aid course available. Frank said yes and that he would send the necessary information to Jacki.

### Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Coaches Certification for Fall Sports is scheduled to be held on Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup>. No list has been received yet from football, cheering or soccer. Parade went well. Dennis spoke with both Luke and Amy. He explained the use of the Friends of Account and how any money left over at the end of the season should be earmarked for future use.

- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Track & Field ending June 2nd. A final practice fun day will be held. End of year gift will be sweatpants. Soccer registration will end June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Girls Softball and Little League Baseball are both going well. Amy rescinded her request to separate the Football and Cheering board and budgets. Amy did request two additional females to represent cheering on the current board. Luke explained that any position on the board could be filled by a man or a woman. **Toni Ann Azzolini:** Men's Softball would like to extend an offer to Carlstadt to join our league. Jacki mentioned that if Carlstadt were to join, they would bring more fields that would become available to the program.
- John Gingerelli made a motion to accept Carlstadt into the Adult Softball program if the current board chooses to go in that direction. The motion was seconded by Barbara Fischkelta. After discussion, a vote was take and all voted yes. Motion passed.*
- d. **Bryon Parisi:** See Rick Reiter (Hearing of Citizens)
- e. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Nothing to report.
- f. **Tony Sartori:** Babe Ruth is running well and rainouts are being scheduled.
- g. **Ezio Altamura:** Spoke with Rich Fallon & Kerri Stellato about the request for insurance support from the Wood Ridge Education Foundation. The GIF will not cover education related programs. The Wood Ridge Board of Education will not cover the events either. Ezio suggested that Kerri call PIA insurance. The Mayor and council will review the five year contract for the use of Pomponio Field. Ezio asked Frank Materia to come to the meeting (see Hearing of Citizens). Jason Cata, WRHS Athletic Director confirmed that there is one AED next to the gym and one in the nurse's office. Neither would be accessible to recreation. Police submitted a grant via the 200 Club to try for additional AED, possibly to put one in the new intermediate school gym. Lightening poles (\$12,000) are being researched by Ed Marino. Ezio is looking into plumbing at Pomponio Field.
- h. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Luke submitted a new budget request for Football and Cheering. Registrations continue to come in but are overall very low. (Cheering – 39, Football – 37, Soccer 70, Summer Recreation – 83, Sr. Ruth – 18) Only 3 volunteers have not yet been hired. **Jerry Lanzerotti made a motion to allow the hiring of Arash Irani if after all of the volunteers are hired. The motion was seconded by Tony Sartori. After discussion, a vote was taken and all voted yes. Motion passed.**
