Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Asked Jerry Lanzerotti to replace him on the Memorial Day Parade Committee. He is unavailable to make the meetings due to other obligations. He also asked Jerry to attend the Youth Night on March 4th in his place as well.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Championship jackets were given to Division 3 & 4 soccer players for their end of year award. Other players were given pajama pants.

- c. **John Gingerelli:** Girl's Softball registration numbers are down.
- d. **Toni Ann Azzonlini:** Nothing to report.
- e. **Bryon Parisi:** Jr. Wrestling held their first home match on Saturday January 4th at the WRHS facility.
- f. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Sophomores are working the clock and scorebook for the recreation games and receiving service hours. Luke Mele was injured and required stitches in a recreation travel basketball game. A meeting was held to discuss the upcoming basketball schedule.
- g. **Tony Sartori:** Little League Baseball meeting at the Civic Center Thursday. No drafts yet. Still taking Babe Ruth Baseball registrations. Jacki is working on the schedule with the help of Phil Romero and Jason Cata. Sr. Ruth is waiting on coaches. Tony Sartori and Fred Dressel to work it out.
- h. **Ezio Altamura:**
 - Just like Little League, we will ask coaches to pay for the AED Certification (approximately \$35)
 - AED Certification will be given by local Fire Department personnel
 - Unit price is \$1,149 with an additional cost of \$89 for pediatric pads
 - We will purchase a total of five units (possibly a sixth to replace 9 year old unit at 14th Street and one for the library)
 - Units are to be placed (WRHS – Donna Ricker Field w/mount, Pomponio Field – to be kept in one of the containers, Union Avenue Field – 14th Street – either move the 9 year old unit from the kitchen to the field w/mount or replace, Doyle School Field w/mount, Civic Center, Senior Center)
 - Need to know if the units require certification or any type of annual inspection or service
 - Need to know if the 9 year old unit at the Union Avenue Field should be replaced

- i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Lyndsey Meyer representatives would like the Recreation Commission to reconsider their decision on their overnight request. After some discussion it was decided that the Recreation Commission would stand by their original decision and there was no motion made. It was suggested that when Jacki inform Melissa of the decision, she mention the possibility of the Assumption Church basement as an alternative. Michael Maloney emailed Jacki about a Jr. Wrestling Camp. Jacki forwarded the information to Rick Reiter for review and requested more detailed information from Mike.

A motion was made by ToniAnn Azzolini to set the 2014 Wood Ridge Recreation registration fees as follows:

Basketball, Wrestling, Indoor Soccer, Girl's Softball, Track & Field, Football & Cheering, & Fall Soccer will be \$50 per player or \$75 for two or more siblings in the same sport.

Babe Ruth Baseball will be \$100 per player with no sibling discount.

Summer Recreation will be \$125 per camper and \$75 for each additional sibling. (\$200 for two siblings, \$275 for three siblings, \$350 for four siblings).

The motion was seconded by Tony Sartori. Vote was taken; all ayes. Motion passed.
