Bobby Jones was in attendance to discuss the 28 new AED’s that were purchased for the borough of Wood Ridge. (Pomponio Field, Sr. Center, Civic Center, Library, Bianchi House, Borough Hall, WRHS, Little League Field, 14th Street Field, Doyle) All AED’s will be in protective cases. Very easy to use, turn on, connect electrodes, start CPR. The AED walks you through the process. All groups were asked to send a representative to this presentation. In attendance were Andrea Marino, Jason Cata, Rich Fallon, Dan Eckert, John Wollerman, Ed Marino, Ben Capello.

Rich Wills was in attendance to discuss the lightening detectors. All have been installed. Detection system is located at borough hall. Will detect lightening 20 miles, 10 miles and 5 miles. When inside of 5 miles, a siren will sound and light begin to flash at WRHS, Doyle, 6th street and 14th street. No false alarms. Battery will be changed every 2 years. WRHS is on a tripod on top of the gym roof, 6th street field is on the 3rd base line, 14th street field is on left field and Doyle is up on the roof near the field. Emails and texts can be sent to all. Flashing light will continue for 30 minutes and the 30 minutes will be reset every time lightening is detected. If lightening is not detected and the 30 minutes is up an all clear sound will be heard and the flashing lights will stop signaling all clear. The Recreation Commission submitted their cell phone numbers so that they are included in the text notifications.
