These are the Recreation Commission Meeting minutes for the Recreation Commission Meeting of May 20, 2015.

Dennis Brubaker called the meeting to order at 8:07 p.m. After the Sunshine Law was read, attendance was taken, attendees were:

A motion was made by Jerry Lanzerotti, to accept the April 15, 2015 minutes. The motion was seconded by Bryon Parisi. A vote was taken; all ayes. Motion passed.

Hearing of Citizens:

(Tom Negro, Russ Christiana)

Tom Negro was in attendance to discuss the Jr. Football/Cheering Board's decision to cancel the election of officers for 2015 that had been requested to be held by the Recreation Commission as a result of the findings at the April meeting. Dennis replied that there was no vote because it would have been against the bylaws. However in the future, they will follow the bylaws. Tom Negro stated that the Jr. Football and Cheering organization has problems starting from the top. There are problems with enrollment. There are problems with meetings being cancelled. There are problems with the way the meetings are conducted. Dennis Brubaker responded that Luke assured him that he was going to move forward by the book and follow the bylaws that are currently in place. Dennis said that he made the decision to move forward because it was time. Dennis also asked Tom why he didn't put his name in for a board position in March. Tom said that he felt that leaving the board in place and not requiring the a new election of officers was the wrong decision. Dennis stated that he will take responsibility for his decision. Russ

Christiana was in attendance to discuss the Jr. Football/Cheering Board and the way they run their meetings. Russ stated that he spoke to board members 2 months in a row detailing what could be done to enhance the program. He received no response. Russ has since offered to be a senior head coach because there was no other coach for the senior team. Russ stated that he has attended PBA meetings for the last 24 years and that the Jr. Football/Cheering Board does not follow Robert's Rules of Order at all and did not follow them at their May meeting which was only a few days prior. There were no treasurer's reports and when questioned they said that there was not much activity. They should have two reports available for meeting attendees, one for the Borough Current Account and one for the Friends of Account. Russ does not want to be a complainer on a regular basis however he is surprised that after 3 or 4 years as president, Luke still does not understand the rules for voting and making motions. The discussion continued and Jacki Goldklang suggested to both Tom and Russ that they stay involved, attend meetings and if they are still interested in board positions in January 2016, they refer to the bylaws as to what they need to do.
