Hearing of Citizens:

Doyle School Music Teacher, Joe LaBelle gave a presentation on a Summer Music Program. He would like to use the Civic Center. Price per student would be \$150-\$175. The program would be held 9 a.m. -12 noon. Three classes would be offered, Music Guitar, Music Theory and Music Literacy. Boys and Girls in grade 2 – 4 would be eligible to participate.

Jerry Lanzerotti made a motion to approve the Summer Music Program as a Wood Ridge Recreation sponsored camp and allow the program to use space in the Civic Center when and where available. Unfinished Business/Committee Reports:

- a. **Dennis Brubaker:** Discussed a problem he was having getting the books for the Coaches Certification classes. They are willing to make copies in groups of 25. Also talked about online certification which is available however there is nothing that would prohibit someone from fast forwarding through the course. Next Coaches Certification is schedule for Monday March 21st.
- b. **Jerry Lanzerotti:** Track & Field numbers are currently very low.
- c. **John Gingerelli:** Girls Softball numbers are currently very low.
- d. **Bryon Parisi:** Nothing new with Jr. Football and Cheering. Board elections to be held next Monday. January meeting was a regular meeting. Jr. Wrestling is hoping to help WRHS Wrestling purchase new mats for WRHS.
- e. **Barbara Fischkelta:** Indoor Soccer is going well. (see Tony's report for Basketball)
- f. **Tony Sartori:** Basketball held a meeting. Dan and his board are doing a wonderful job. Recreation Basketball rules were changed to allow the coach to decide the amount of playing time a child has within specified guidelines.

- h. **Pat Ambrosio:** Girls' Softball will host a fundraiser at Angeloni's, 7-11 p.m. on April 16th, Adults only.
- i. **Ezio Altamura:** Field at 14th Street is done. Little League Field is done. Park at 13th Street will be renovated as a Passive Park. WRHS Turf Field concrete for the lights is ready to go. Lights should be completed in March/April. Chris Eilert will for a committee as to the usage of the lights. Youth Government Day will be held on Wednesday March 16th. Charlie Trentacosti is hosting Scoring Points for Kids. The profits (50%) will be split between WRHS Football, Athletics and National Honor Society.
- j. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** A list of the Rules of the Civic/Senior Centers was distributed to all and posted in both buildings in an effort to Keep the Buildings in better condition. A letter was received from a Girls' Softball Parent and forwarded to John Wollerman. Jacki mentioned that the Recreation Commission should discuss the policy of sponsoring the Open Gym Programs. Received a flyer from the Basketball Board which had the names of the WRHS Girls and Boys Basketball Coaches on it in conjunction with Coaching the Spring Basketball Program. Dan Eckert called the state and they said that it is a gray zone as to whether the Fall 2017 Freshman can be coached by the High School Coaches. They will get back to him and he will report back to us. In the meantime, the names of the WRHS Coaches will be removed from the flyer and the flyer will be distributed.
