- h. **Ezio Altamura:** The Borough of Wood Ridge Youth Day will be held on March 1st. Ezio gave a brief presentation on the resolution for the 12 acres of space that will be purchased and developed for recreation use. The application to the NJ Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program will be for the Recreation Complex at Westmont Station. Tentative plans were shown as well. Dennis Brubaker read the resolution aloud for all to hear and a copy was sent to each Recreation Commissioner for consideration prior to the meeting. *Barbara Fischkelta made a motion to accept and approve the resolution to submit an application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program to fund property acquisition (12 acres) and development of a Recreation Complex at Westmont Station. The motion was seconded by Pat Ambrosio. - i. **Recreation Report (Jacki Goldklang):** Reported that Indoor Soccer had Wood Ridge Moonachie Soccer on their uniform shirts. All agreed to send out a reminder that the only sport that has Moonachie in the name is Jr. Football as a result of the charter. All recreation sports should be known as Wood Ridge or Blue Devils. In the sports in which we accept Kindergarten age children, we go by the school cut off which is October 1st of the year that a child will enter Kindergarten. A parent whose child misses the cut off by 9 days is questioning whether the Recreation Commission can make an exception. All agreed not to make an exception. No motion needed. Milan Soccer camp will be held in Hoboken this Summer. Iron Reign CrossFit will host a special program for our football players to stay in shape over the winter (organized by Bob Valenti). Mike Carcich is hosting a coach's clinic for Little League. Who is holding the insurance for the clinic? Recreation Commission agreed it should be Little League. U.S. Sports will not be hosting their Multi Sport camp this Summer because there is not an available week in between the end of school and start of Summer Recreation. Jacki will speak to them to discuss possible alternate dates.
