- i. Food Recall: Thrive Market is recalling nut butters for potential contamination with listeria; General Mills is recalling 5 lb bags of flour for possible salmonella contamination; Perdue is recalling 16,011 lbs ready to eat nuggets for undeclared allergens;

- j. Hill's Pet Nutrition is recalling select canned dog food due to elevated vitamin D; Maxfield Seafood is recalling 55,300 lbs of fish products that were not presented for import re-inspection at the US Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service;

- l. Food Recall: Multistate outbreak of Salmonella linked to pre-cut melon report;

Drug & Medical Device Recall: Legacy Pharmaceuticals is recalling lots of Losartan Tablets USP 50mg due to trace amounts of Nitroso Methy butyric acid and possible impurity or contaminant in an active pharmaceutical ingredient; Pfizer is recalling ThermaCare Back Pain Therapy HeatWraps 16hr pain relief as they can have a higher cell temperature than specified; AmEx Pharmacy is recalling Bevacizumab Injectable Syringe as the product may become difficult to express;
