The meeting of the Shade Tree Commission of September 9, 2019 was opened and called to order at 6:33 PM by Chairman George Meglio.

Chairman Meglio discussed the NJ Shade Tree Federation Conference, October 24 & 25, 2019 in Atlantic City. – George Meglio, Angelo Urato & Elizabeth Gil will attend. 24-32 credits can be received if classes are attended.

Chairman Meglio spoke about the upcoming Fall Planting season. Chairman Meglio has 30 trees ordered. Letters will be delivered to residents on the dead ends of Marlboro Rd, Windsor Rd., Innes Rd & Sussex Rd. They have a deadline of September 16th to let the Shade Tree Commission know if they do not want a tree. A second round of letter will go out to other residents with a deadline of September 23rd. Chairman Meglio to work on these addresses.

Chairman Meglio addressed the following residents who have requested trees:

- O'Donnell – 318 Hillcrest Ave.

A discussion ensued about all of the trees removed along Valley Blvd and planters being installed with seasonal flowers and also by the Transformation Life Church. Chairman Meglio will speak to Reverend Armpriester to see if he will allow the Shade Tree to plant on his property.

Commissioner Gil advised there were several locations she was waiting for removal

Commissioner Urato addressed a lifting sidewalk & tree roots between the 165 Tenth & 167 Tenth (see attached pictures).
