### **Hearing of Citizens:**

Jeff & Tracy Katz were in attendance to observe and find out information on W-R Recreation & Travel Basketball. NJ Governor Phil Murphy announced that all indoor sports can resume in New Jersey which for W-R includes Basketball, Competitive Cheering, Indoor Soccer & Wrestling. Under the order – which takes effect immediately – attendance at practices and competition is limited to 25% of a room’s capacity, or 25 people maximum, whichever number is lower. But if the number of people necessary, such as athletes, coaches, and referees, exceeds 25, spectators and others will be prohibited. Still, even if this exception applies, the number of people allowed cannot exceed 25% of the room’s capacity, and the limit cannot exceed 150 people. A committee was formed to look into recreation & travel basketball, come up with a plan and report back to the Recreation Commission in November. (Barbara, Dan, Jacki, Loriann & Ray)
