Resident at 84 Rose St. received a tree; she was very happy. The resident who had his contractor remove a Borough Tree had received a summons & a fine. They will be paying the Borough \$1,100.00.


Chairman Meglio stated that we will plant more trees in the fall. He also mentioned that Avalon has been planting a lot of trees; they've been very good. Getting to their second season now so they have to be pruned & elevated.

PSE&G manager called Chairman Meglio – paid a compliment. He said we are one of the best towns; not too many trees here to trim, very well maintained in the entire State.

Chairman Meglio advised that we replaced 3 American Elms across from him on the hill at 14th St. Field. Borough Administrator Eilert also planted some trees along the back stop as well. Also, he planted about 200 trees at the dead ends of Sussex, Innes and Windsor Roads-Little Giants. In the fall we will plant another dozen or so trees. So by in large we had a positive planting season.
