**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 283, ENTITLED FIRE PREVENTION**

A summary of Ordinance 2024-21 appears below:

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 283 of the Borough Code, entitled Fire Prevention, to update certain provisions of the code to reflect current practices and policies required by the NJ Division of Fire Safety, provide for annual inspections of certain properties and buildings that are not Life Hazard Uses, codify current practices and policies for fire safety precautions such as posting fire watches and requirements for identifying signs, public safety radio coverage, and emergency key boxes on certain buildings, and updating of the fee schedule for fire prevention permits and certificates.
