AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ENTITLED BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, AND ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 128, ENTITLED RECREATION DEPARTMENT

A summary of Ordinance 2025-9 appears below:

The purpose of this ordinance is to create a new chapter of the Borough Code to establish a Recreation Department and to amend the chapter of the Borough code entitled Boards and Commissions to establish a Board of Recreation. This ordinance establishes the organization, structure, powers and duties of the Recreation Department and the Board of Recreation. It also updates and clarifies the authority and responsibility for overseeing the policies, operations and finances of the Borough's youth sports and recreation programs, including the summer recreation program.
